Robert Lyon "Bob" Waren, 31, of Fayetteville, formerly of New York, has gone to be with his Lord on Thursday, March 2, 2006, after a long and courageous battle with kidney cancer.

Bob was a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill with a degree from the Kenan-Flagler School of Business. He had worked at Bear Wagner Specialist, LLC in New York City since 2000 as a financial analyst. He was a member of St. James Episcopal Church in Manhattan, N.Y.

He is survived by his parents, Marshall and Sandee Waren; his brother and sister-in-law and his nephews, M. Hughes Jr. and Janet A. Waren, and Marshall H. Waren III and Griffith M. Waren.
